Behavior-based Safety Activity

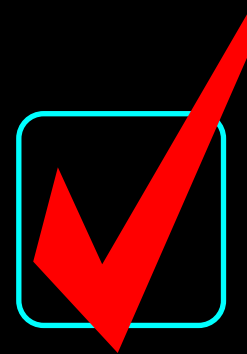
Outcome of the activity:

Outcome of the activity:

- Through role-playing, students will become familiar with:
 - Workforce participation
 - Targeting unsafe behaviors
 - Observational data collection
 - Data-driven decision-making
 - Intervention



Behavior-based Safety Activity

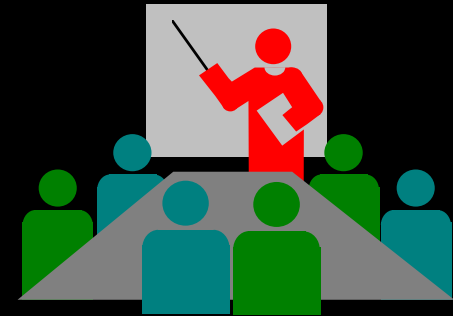
Steps of the activity:

- Students will form into groups of 4
 - 2 observers
 - 2 workers
- The observers will “observe” the workers performing a mock work task

Behavior-based Safety Activity

Steps of the activity:

- Each group will use the worksheets to document all aspects of the program creation.
 - Unsafe behaviors
 - Observational data collection
 - Data-driven decision-making
 - Intervention
 - Feedback



Behavior-based Safety Activity

Steps of the activity:

- Each group will then choose an individual to state their results (program created)
- After each group has stated their results, the entire class will discuss the outcomes

Behavior-based Safety Activity

Tips to a successful activity:

- All group members must assume the role given
- Communication within the group is critical
- Document all steps of the process
- All members of the group must be genuine with their thoughts
